## Adult Basic Education Policies

### Upgrading

Please note that Adult Basic Education (ABE) is provided by Woodland Cree First Nation Education Authority.

### Eligibility

Must register and complete intake forms

### Application Process

- Request an application or visit <https://wcfnea.ca/> adult education to print off an application package.
- Email completed applications to [sponsorship@cadottelakeschool.ca](mailto:sponsorship@cadottelakeschool.ca)
- WCFNEA requires at least 14 working days to process and review COMPLETED applications. Incomplete applications will be sent back.
- All continuing students MUST reapply before May 31 of each school.

### Program Delivery

- Courses start and end in semesters - Fall semester Sept.-Jan.; Winter semester Feb.-June
- Registration will remain open for anyone seeking to upgrade course marks
- Majority of the program will be delivered online or with paper modules at the Adult Learning Center
- Adult Learning Center is available for all student support. Please visit <https://wcfnea.ca/> to find operational hours.

### Course Completion Incentives

- Tuition costs will be 100% covered by WCFNEA..
- Students can take up to 4 courses per semester
- Students who successfully complete credits will receive financial incentives.

### Technology Support

Computer access is available at the Adult Learning Center

Students requiring a computer must indicate this on the application or contact the Adult Education Coordinator.

Limited laptops will be available to borrow and must be returned when the ABE program is over.

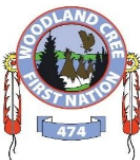
*Laptops not returned in good condition may impact additional requests for sponsorship.*
